



He is also the Co-Founder of No Reverse Records and Artistic and Creative Director for The Rusty Anchor Acting Company (RAAC), and graduate of The University of Cincinnati, CCM with a BFA in Musical Theatre.

As a Record Producer, Mitchell has been on the Billboard Cast Album Chart twice with Frankie: The Musical #9 and Shards of an Honor Code Junkie #12. With other albums hitting #1 on iTunes R&B, #1 on iTunes Blues, #1 on Amazon Classical Crossover, and winning Broadway World's Solo album of the year (2016) and the Decade (2010 - 2020). 
